The 6-storey block comprising 3 levels of office, totalling some 240,000 sf, on top of another 3 levels of parking, integrates all operational and administrative functions of the AirAsia Group with supporting conference and recreational facilities for the Alistars, the moniker given to the highly driven employees. Covering an area of approximately 4.8 acres, the project site is located just beside the new Low Cost Carrier Terminal (LCCT) of Kuala Lumpur International Airport (KLIA 2).

A cornucopia of meeting pods, conference rooms, chill-out areas and casual work stations are individually decorated so that


