VERITAS FUND FOR EXCELLENCE (VFE)

The VERITAS Fund for Excellence or VFE is a special CSR fund which was founded in 2004 by the VERITAS Design Group to further our core values of Integrity, Design, Environment, Audacity and Service. It arose from a vision to encourage more design students and educators to excel in their respective fields and eventually contribute further toward nation building.



Next year VERITAS will launch its latest VFE project: the 'Adopt-a-Park' program in collaboration with Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL). VERITAS Landscape Sdn Bhd conceived of the initiative and is spear-heading this project, which will involve identifying pockets of poorly landscaped roadside areas in Kuala Lumpur, and then enhancing and beautifying these areas using funds donated by the private sector.





These "adoptions" will involve the development and maintenance of these mini-parks and open spaces by DBKL for a period of two years after which they will be re-adopted by other companies. The Adopt-a-Park project is scheduled to be officially launched by the Mayor of Kuala Lumpur in March 2015, and VERITAS will undertake the adoption of the first park.

VERITAS CARE SCHEME

COST AWARENESS by RESPONSIBILITY towards the ENVIRONMENT The CARE scheme is a sustainability initiative which was launched in 2007 and which has

been practiced by VERITASians ever since. How CARE is practiced in VERITAS?

We recycle paper, plastic and aluminum cans and the arising

monies are transfered to the CARE fund. We benchmark electricity consumption by average usage per

- month. Then, for a particular month, if the usage is less than this average cost, the Company reimburses the savings to the CARE Fund. We encourage more drivers (those who are given Company Petrol Cards) to switch their bigger engine cars to smaller ones.
- Penalties are imposed on the owners of large engine capacity vehicles and these monies are deposited into the CARE fund. We encourage carpooling or use of public transport and monies saved from payments to the Car Park Management are re-imbursed to the CARE fund.
- The money collected in the CARE FUND is then paid out quarterly to those VERITASians who use public transportation. Through this social and environmental responsibility initiative, VERITAS is contributing to

environmental sustainability while returning to deserving VERITASians a part of what we have received in terms of support and goodwill from our Clients.

VERITAS EXCEPTIONAL SERVICE PRACTICES (VERITAS ESP)

The VERITAS ESP, launched in 2009, is a set of detailed guidelines practiced diligently by VERITAS "front-line" service providers to enhance the overall experience of the professional service received by our Clients.
