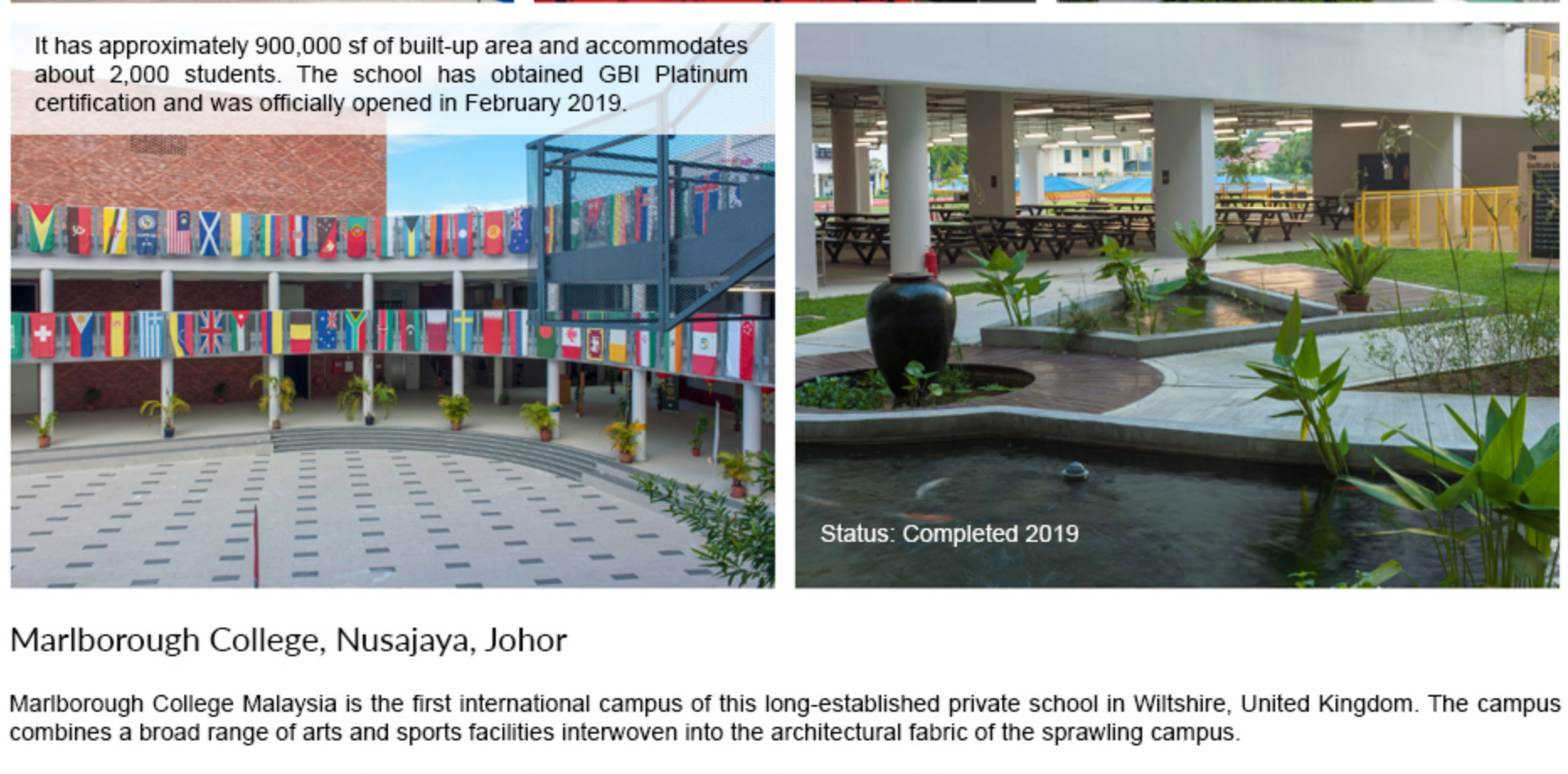


VERITAS Education Portfolio

At VERITAS, institutional and educational work has always been an important component of our portfolio, and we have always given it our fullest attention despite its relatively modest scale compared to our "high-profile" projects. In viewing this current range of work, we hope you will agree.

International School Of Kuala Lumpur (ISKL), Jalan Ampang Hillir, Kuala Lumpur

The new ISKL campus sits on a massive 25.7-acre site along Jalan Ampang Hillir. In a collaboration between VERITAS and HOK Architects of London, the school was designed to create an advanced educational learning environment, featuring world-class academic and athletic resources.

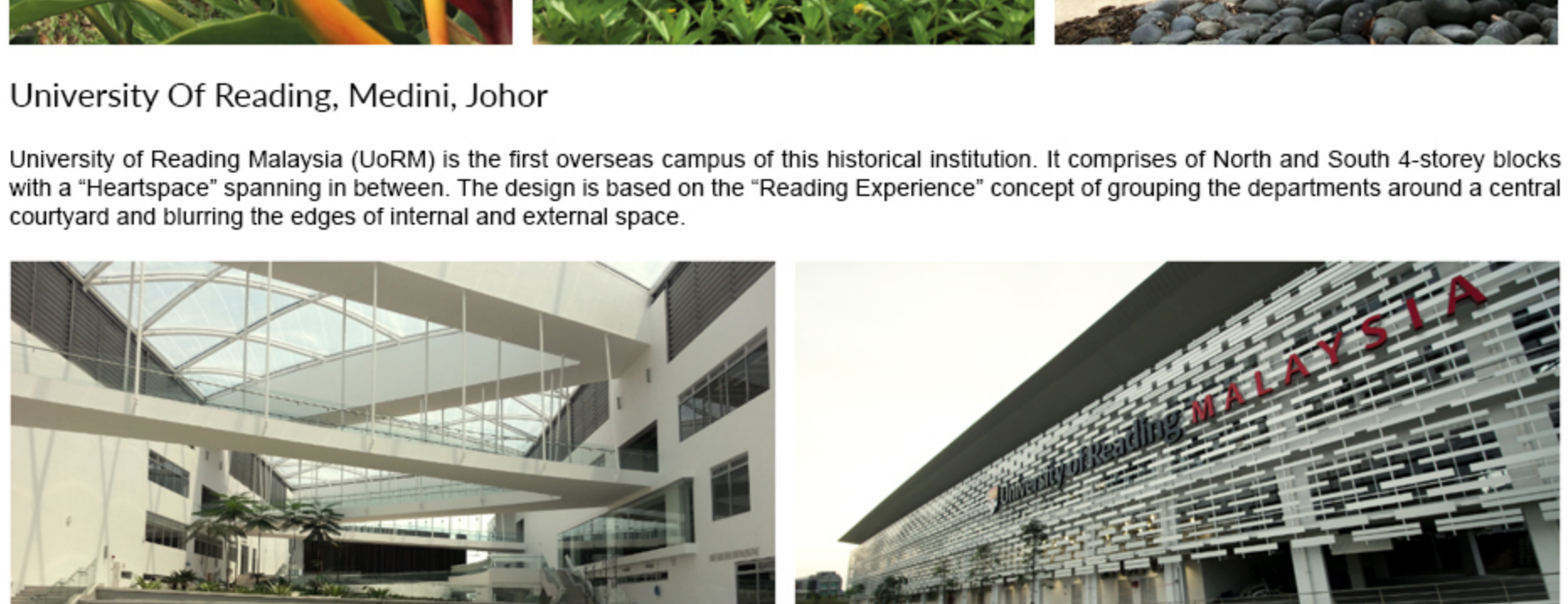


It has approximately 900,000 sq ft of built-up area and accommodates about 2,000 students. The school has obtained GBI Platinum certification and was officially opened in February 2019.



Marlborough College, Nusajaya, Johor

Marlborough College Malaysia is the first international campus of this long-established private school in Wiltshire, United Kingdom. The campus combines a broad range of arts and sports facilities interwoven into the architectural fabric of the sprawling campus.



The landscape, which was designed by VERITAS Landscapes, focuses on the development of a lush 'campus-style' parkland that connects the interior and exterior spaces.

The modernist design continues with the selection of plant species to complement the overall institutional character of the project.

The architectural design of the junior school was also done by VERITAS in collaboration with HOK Architects.

Status: Completed 2018

University Of Reading, Medini, Johor

University of Reading Malaysia (UoRM) is the first overseas campus of this historical institution. It comprises of North and South 4-storey blocks with a "HeartSpace" spanning in between. The design is based on the "Reading Experience" concept of grouping the departments around a central courtyard and blurring the edges of internal and external space.



Components of UoRM include a learning resource centre, areas for student societies and staff development and facilities for student services. The UoRM campus accommodates 2,000 students and 400 teaching and support staff and was designed in collaboration with Scott Browning Architects of UK.

St. Joseph's Institution International School (Sjii), Petaling Jaya, Selangor

The 6-acre site of SJII is relatively flat with a slight depression towards the rear. With a total built-up area of about 300,000 sq ft, the school is able to cater to approximately 1,800 students for the full educational term with a teacher to student ratio of one to fifteen.



The architectural approach is inspired by the institution's core values which focus on people and their inter-relationships. This spirit of interaction is expressed in the open-air design of the link-ways and corridors that permit natural ventilation and connect all blocks at every floor, thus encouraging students to communicate and socialize.

Status: Completed 2016

The building adopted sustainable design concepts and obtained Green Building Index (GBI) certification

Stonyhurst International School, Penang

Slated to open in 2019 in Penang, this is yet another international branch of an established British independent school; Stonyhurst College in Lancashire, UK. This co-ed school will be located on the Tanjung Tokong waterfront and will eventually accommodate 1,200 students aged three to 18 following the British curriculum with Jesuit principles and values at its core.

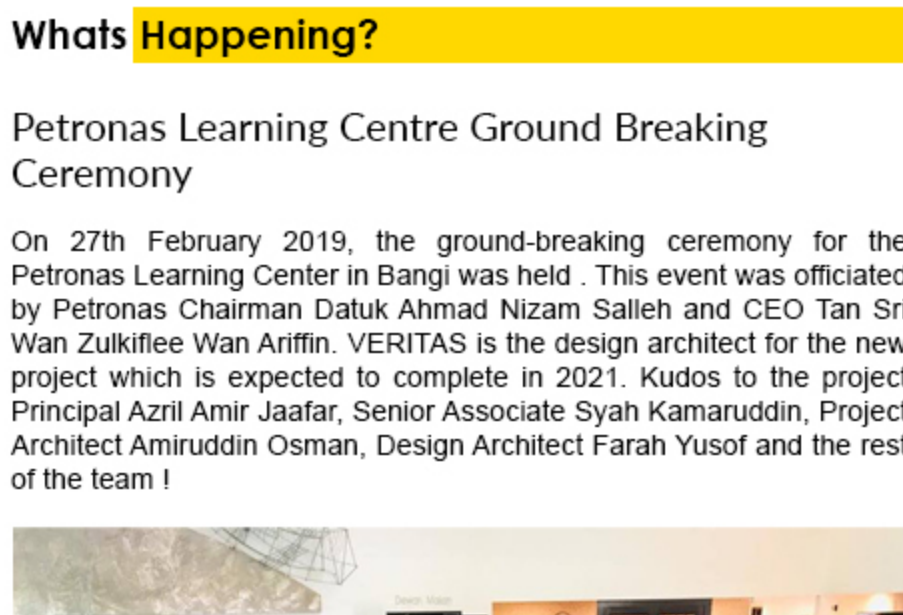
Three's Entrepreneurial Company

Star Property Award 2019

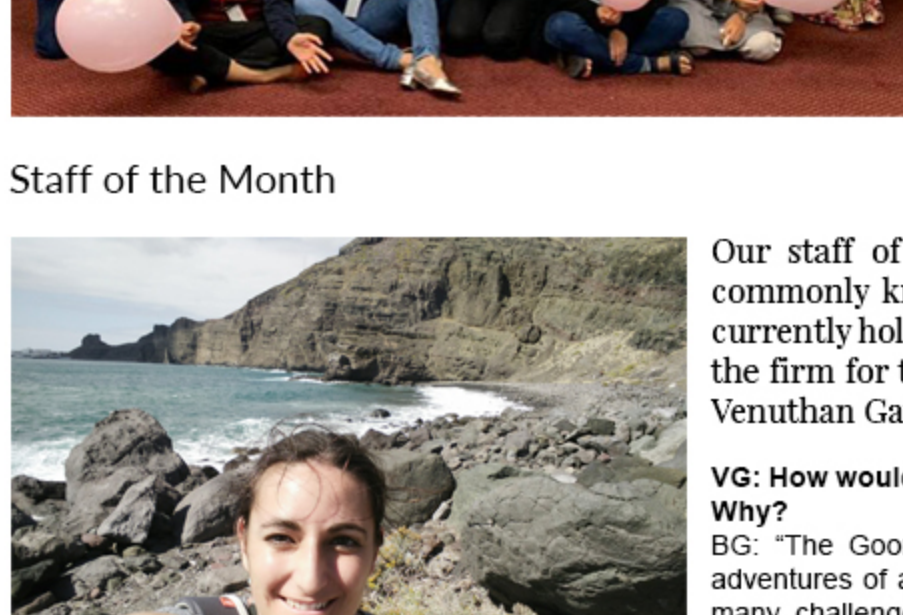

Staff of the Month

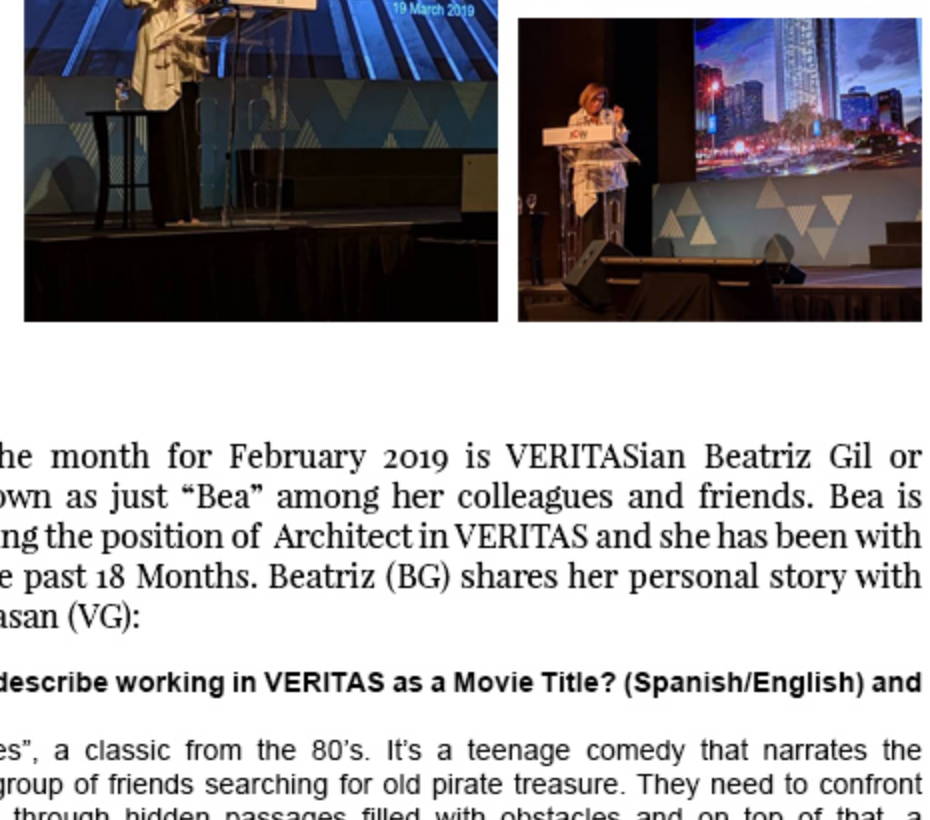

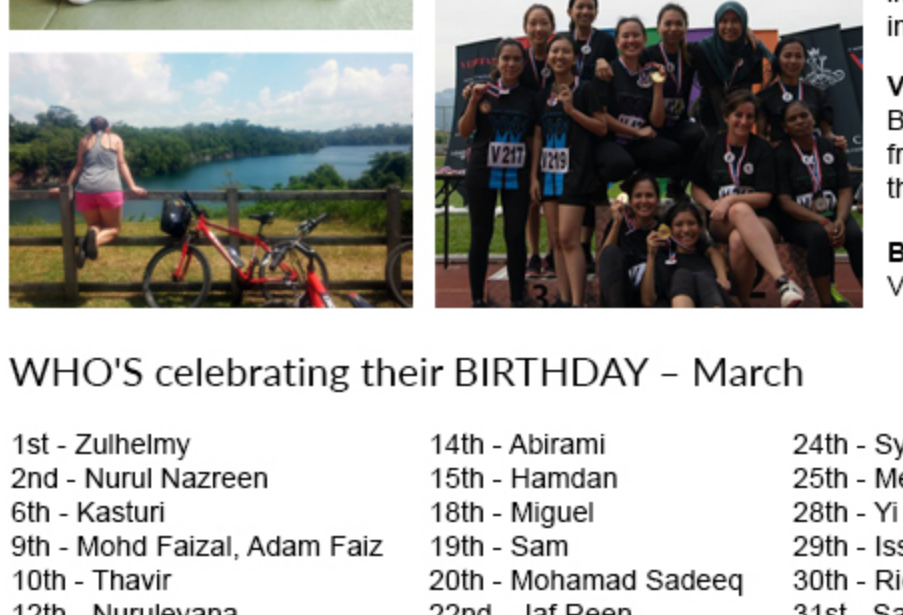

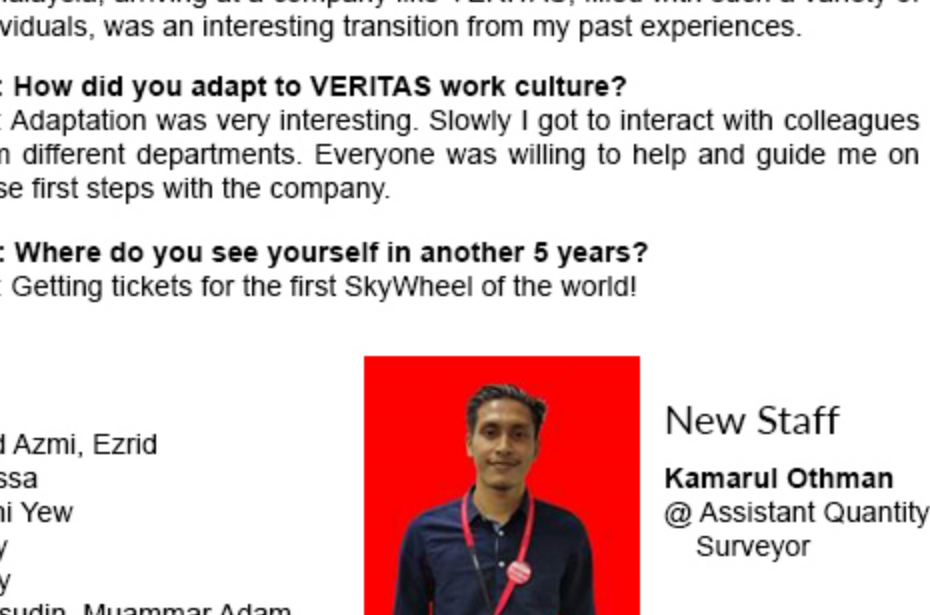
