Rimbun Kasia is a 30-acre greenfield site directly adjacent to a newly established residential area, surrounded by multiple schools and institutes of higher learning at the heart of Taman Desa Kasia, Nilai in the state of Negeri Sembilan. This development thus caters to an expected surge in demand for housing anticipated in the greater Nilai area. The sloping topography of the site gives way to a forest serve; a rare natural setting within what is becoming a hard urbanscape in Nilai



he site is divided into 5 residential parcels, each designed to a different typology and unit size depending on the targeted market and phasing requirements. Site ingress and egress is via a main entrance road that bisects a welcoming crescent shaped plaza and a landmark

The SINKEH, a boutique hotel in Lebuh Melayu in George Town, Penang, does not stand in the conventional sense. There's no ornately carved door, intricate embellishments or a vibrant paint job. But once you find it, you realize it is something truly special. The top part of this 19th century shop-house retains the historical Straits Chinese architecture with its original shutters, weathered and time-worn. This however is in stark contrast to the bottom part, where the entrance is located, which dominated by a raw concrete wall anchored on both sides by glass panel. Rather unexpectedly, on the bare cement wall is a vine with large palm-like leaves that has the desired effect of softening the otherwise somber, imposing appearance. A towering door made from recycled timber with an antique knocker serves as the entrance while an oxidized metal plank with 'Sinkeh' carved out in block letters tells us we are indeed at the right place.

Happenings "Adopt a Park"

Under the VERITAS Fund for Excellence (VFE) program, VERITAS recently launched its latest initiate; the Adopt-a-park scheme! Conceived by VERITAS and gifted to Kuala Lumpur, the scheme invites private companies to support the creation and maintenance of 'pocket-parks' around the city by contributing to a special fund established under the control of Dewan Bandaraya Kuala Lumpur (DBKL).



Under the terms of this adoption DBKL will build and upkeep the pocket-park of a period of 2 years and maintain signage of the adoptee company within the park. In addition to conceiving of the scheme, VERITAS also adopted the first pocket-park, a 300sm median area infront of KLCC which includes the installation of walkways, artwork, garden lights, shady trees and ornamental shrubs. Memorandum of Agreement (M.O.A) signing ceremony was officiated by Tan Sri Haji Ahmad Phesal bin Hi Talib, the Mayor of Kuala Lumpur and David Mizan Hashim, Group President of VERITAS.


CONGRATULATORY DINNER
