
Associates, United States of America, Menara Mulpha is a 30-storey high office tower located in the shadow of the Kuala Lumpur Twin Towers, within the high-rise zone of the Kuala Lumpur city centre.

Located on a square site, Menara Mulpha's floor plan is a truncated ellipse with its tapered point orientated towards the streetfront.

by an alucobond edge that nearly completely enfolds the tapered tip of the elevation. The glass and metal spandrel panels along the facade of the building give it a strong

The project obtained approved from city hall in 2008 but the land was sold and the new owner has unfortunately decided to construct a residential tower instead. Ministry of International Trade and Industry (MITI), Jalan Duta, Kuala Lumpur

With a landscaped site given wide berth by surrounding developments, the MITI building is sited on a rise on the grounds and is divided almost in equal measure into vertical and



lines of an intricate screen, yet strong enough to give the tower definition as it curves over the topmost floor. The auditorium and conference spaces are given the same treatment albeit with a strong horizontal expression, with its over-sailing roofs becoming the entrance canopy joining

both components of the building.


