The Klang Valley Mass Rapid Transit Project (also known as "Klang Valley MRT Project", or just MRT) is a proposed 3-line mass rapid transit

system for the Greater Kuala Lumpur conurbation in Malaysia.

The MRT Project will not only significantly increase the current inadequate rail network, but will also serve to integrate all existing transportation networks and alleviate the severe traffic congestion in the Greater KL metropolitan area.



The Line 1 and 2 stations designed by VERITAS comprise prominent metropolitan points of interchange at locations as Bukit Bintang, Pasar Seni, Muzium and Stadium Merdeka. The fast-track design of the stations means that a lot more emphasis is placed on the modularity and constructability of the building components. The project is currently under construction and is expected to be completed by 2017. The multi-faceted formation of the station roofs form the primary design concept which is then layered with individual identity themes, bearing influences from the locality of each station. 


